

As you prepare for PRIDoC 2024 in Adelaide, please follow these instructions to access the official information about the Subclass 601 Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) visa:

**\*\*\* Please note for entry into Australia, you require a valid visa\*\*\***

1. Visit the official Australian Government Department of Home Affairs website using this link:

2. On this page, you'll find comprehensive information about the ETA visa. The page is divided into several sections for easy navigation:

- Overview
- About this visa
- Eligibility
- Step by step (How to apply)
- When you have this visa

3. To view step-by-step application instructions, scroll down to the "How to apply" section. Here, you'll find detailed information on the application process. We recommend watching the how to videos as all steps are not obvious. Ex. How to scan your passport

4. Pay special attention to the "Step by step" subsection. This provides a clear, sequential guide to completing your application.

5. For specific eligibility requirements, refer to the "Eligibility" section above "How to apply." You will NOT be entering health care or hospital environments so do not click on that section.

6. If you need to check processing times, scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the "Global visa processing times" link. This can calculate the expected time, however please complete your application as soon as possible.

7. For any additional questions, consult the "Frequently asked questions" link at the bottom of the page.

Obtaining an Australian Visa is **mandatory**. Remember to review all information carefully before starting your application. If you encounter any difficulties navigating the website or have questions about the content, please don't hesitate to reach out for assistance. There will be a AU\$20 fee towards the end of the process.
